

## Scores Competition Sep 17<sup>th</sup> – Dec 3<sup>rd</sup> 2020 & 7<sup>th</sup> Jan – 11<sup>th</sup> Feb 2021

From Thursday September 17<sup>th</sup> there will be a free to enter 12-week scores competition with prizes presented at the end of the competition. As is normal at the moment we are limited to a maximum of 18 or 24 players on any day, if you are the 19/25<sup>th</sup> player or greater you will not get to play on that day unless someone leaves after the 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> round.

Thursdays are arranged as normal and all you do is enter each of your game outcomes on the sheet provided. If you **do not wish** to enter the competition then do not put your results on the sheet \*.

**Entry is free so you have nothing to lose and the more you attend the better your chances of winning a prize.**

Weekly Autumn scores competition will run from Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> September 2020 for 12 weeks there will be a break for lockdown 2 and the Christmas and New year periods.

Each time you turn up on a Thursday you will be given 1 point for each game you play irrespective of whether you win, lose or draw the game.

Before entering the results on the score sheet check the result with your opponent's \*.

You will receive 0 extra points for a game loss (making a total of 1 point)

You will receive 1 extra point for a game draw (making a total of 2 points)

You will receive 2 extra points for a game win (making a total of 3 points)

You will receive 3 extra points for a game you win 13-X (making a total of 4 points)

So, if you turn up and play 3 games and lose all 3 games you will get 3 points.

Likewise, if you turn up and play only 2 games and win 1 game 13-X and win the other you will get a total of 7 points.

There will be prizes for the top 3 Ladies, top 3 Men and a 'mystery prize'.

If there is a point's tie then the person who played fewer games to gain the points, takes the higher position.

Prizes will be presented at the earliest opportunity after the last round has been played.

It is up to you to enter the Win 13, Win, Draw or Loss on the sheet provided\*.

If there is no sheet available then that week is void for everyone.

The weekly leader board will be available as a printed copy on a Thursday to view and available to view by anyone on the Cirencester Pétanque website.
